Luke 15:30. So he set off and went to his father. But while he was still far off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion; he ran and put his arms around him and kissed him. The first day I dropped my older child off for preschool was gut wrenching. I couldn't think straight or even focus. I watched the clock all day because I wanted her back. I was sitting in the parking lot waiting for 3pm. What sweet relief I felt when I could hold her in my arms and hear her voice again. Imagine how God feels, wanting just one of us to come back. God longs to rush towards us, and have a party in our honor. If the parable of the prodiggal son illustrates even a fraction of how God rejoices over us when we come home again after wandering away, we're not ready for that level of love. Perhaps we never can be. God asks us to help do this work of reconnection and reconciliation. God askes us to love each other just like this.
