SOMETHING TO THINK ABOUT

Is there such a thing as spiritual
blindness-unable to see God’s work even
when its right in front of you?

You may recall the story of the man
stranded in a flood on his roof. A boat
comes by and offers help and he responds
“I’m waiting for God to save me.” A
helicopter offers a rope and he says “No,
I am waiting for God to save me.”
Eventually he drowns. When he sees God,
he asks “Lord I believed in you, why
didn’t you come and save me.” God
responds, “Oh my son, I sent you a boat
and a helicopter!”

When God reveals His work to us, let us
be ready to see and believe. God works in
mysterious ways – and blatantly obvious
ways too!

REFLECTION

One of the most helpful discoveries I
made during seminary was the practice
of breath prayer. This ancient form of
prayer, which can be traced back to the
desert fathers and mothers in the third
century, can be used to calm the mind
and the body in times of chaos or
anxiety.

This simple practice involves reciting a
piece of scripture, taking a deep breath
through the nose, holding for a beat or
two, and then exhaling while reciting the
rest of the scripture. This breath prayer
helped to calm me down and provided a
valuable transition from one period of my
day to another. I often sit in my car for a
few moments in the parking lot when I
arrive at work and in my driveway at the
end of the day, offering prayer and
centering myself for what is to come.
The psalms are particularly suited to
breath prayer and provide both a pause
and an opportunity to pray unceasingly
amid our hectic lives.
