REFLECTION

*Matthew 11:28 Come to me, all you that are
weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I
will give you rest.*

Not long ago, I was plagued with
insomnia, that feeling when sleep just
will not come, or if it does, it isn't restful.
Whether I was turning over the events of
the day or pre-planning for the day ahead
(a polite word for worrying), I couldn't
seem to help my brain find quiet. Four
a.m. can feel like the loneliest, longest
hour in the world.

When sleep seemed impossible, I began
lifting others in prayer. I offered
intercessory prayers for those I knew who
were ill, for all who "work, or watch, or
weep this night," and for all those around
the world who were also staring and wide
awake in the middle of the night. With
enough practice, I could focus on others
and on Jesus instead of the whirling
thoughts of my brain.

Sometimes, sleep is still illusive, yet I
trust that Jesus keeps me company even
then.
