### THE WAY OF THE CROSS

For the next 14 weeks, we are going on a journey with Jesus, to the cross, for reflection & meditation.

Opening prayer: Lord Jesus, throughout your life on earth, you showed how we are called to live in relationship with the Father. You prayed often, seeking to know his will.
