REFLECTIONS ON THE WAY OF THE CROSS

We continue as Jesus' journey becomes more intense.

“Station 10” *Jesus Is Stripped of His Garments*

The soldiers strip off your clothes, Jesus, and now you have lost just about everything. You look more like a common criminal than a victorious king. As I reflect on your diminishment, it strikes me that this is what it means to pray, “Your will be done.” You have given up power, possessions, even any sense of control, and placed all you are and all you have into the Father's hands. Teach me to share your deep confidence in His abiding love.

“Station 11” *Jesus Is Nailed to the Cross*
“Deliver us from the evil one.” You prayed. Still, in this moment, it looks as if evil will have the final say. Your body is bruised, bloodied and broken – your arms stretched out, unable to fend off the cruel blows. I find it all very hard to understand: Why doesn't God deliver you – deliver us – from life's most painful moments? When my faith wavers, Lord, reach out your crucified hand to me and lift me up. Let me share in your strength.
