REFLECTIONS ON THE WAY OF THE CROSS  
*We continue as Jesus’ journey becomes more intense.*

“Station 12” *Jesus Dies on the Cross*  
How often, Lord Jesus, have I brought sin into the world by choosing my will over “your will”? And yet, it is you who must pay the price. “Be amazed at this, O heavens, and shudder with sheer horror, says the Lord... They have forsaken me, source of living waters”. Forgive me, Lord, for all the times I have turned away from you. Touch my tongue with your living water and change my heart so that it beats in unison with Yours.

“Station 13” *Jesus Is Taken Down from the Cross*  
“All his acquaintances stood at a distance” after the crucifixion, writes Luke. I can see myself among them- not only horrified by the spectacle, but frightened by the example you have given us. Can I ever be strong enough to empty myself so completely, as you did on the cross? In my moments of weakness, Lord Jesus, fortify me with your grace. Help me to cling to you whenever I despair of being able to do your will.
